

1.) Registration

Registration for the IASRE Dent Championship is exclusively via the
to complete the registration form on the IASRE website.

Registration closes one week before the start of the trade fair.

The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

(eligibility by date)

The participation fee is €90 including VAT.

Only payment entitles you to participate in the "IASRE Dent Press Championship". There is no right to reimbursement in the event of non-participation.

2.) Eligibility

Any dent technician who has at least two years of experience or reliable references is eligible to participate. There is no claim to admission.

3.) Vehicles:

Only vehicles from the same manufacturer or the same type will be processed.

4.) Damage pattern:

The damage pattern is generated artificially.

Two dents are processed per participant. Adhesive technology - roof frame

Push technology - door

5.) Allocation of the dents for the participant

The dents to be processed per participant will be assigned by drawing lots. The damage is clearly marked according to the lot number.

One ticket will be awarded per participant.

6.) Tools

Each participant works with their own tools including lighting. A 230V connection will be provided by the organizer.

If you use 12V systems, please think about the necessary batteries and connections.

7.) Violations

The vehicles may NOT be drilled.

The processed dents must NOT be reworked with sandpaper.

NO electrical Devices (Multiliner or similar) are used to repair dents.

The vehicles are parked in a delimited area. During the dent repair competition, access to this area is restricted to the respective participant and jury members only.

Only hand polishing is allowed.

Failure to comply with any of these points will result in immediate disqualification.

8.) Procedure

Registration and ticket number (Fridays from 09.00-10.00) The start time will be communicated to the participants after the draw.

The competitor should report to the jury 10 minutes before their starting time. The duration of the dent repair is recorded using a stopwatch.

Max. 1 participant per vehicle side.

9.) Timing

Max. repair time 60 min. (for both components)

10.) Rating

The assessment is made immediately after the repair by 3-5 referees (experts, dent technicians) using tools. (dent reflector, dent lamps)

The evaluation is based on a points system (quality-time)

Final round of participants: The six best-placed participants of the preliminary round.

The start time and dent of the individual participants will be determined the day before by lottery and communicated to the participants.

1.) Damage pattern

The damage pattern is generated artificially.

One dent will be processed per participant. One (1) dent across the edge

Pressing and gluing technology

2.) Processing time

45 minutes

3.) Violations

The vehicles may NOT be drilled.

The processed dents must NOT be reworked with sandpaper.

NO electrical Devices (Multiliner or similar) are used to repair dents. Hot air dryer is allowed.

The vehicles are parked in a delimited area. Access to this area is only permitted to the respective participants and jury members during the repair of the dent.

Failure to comply with any of these points will result in immediate disqualification.

4.) Rating

The assessment is made immediately after the repair by 3-5 referees (experts, dent technicians) using tools. (dent reflector, dent lamps). The evaluation is based on a points system (quality-time)

5.) Award ceremony and announcement of the winners
